Homework Choices Year 3 Spring 2019

Next half term the children will be learning about weather.

- Can you make your own rain gauge (or other weather instrument) to measure the weather? Record the information you find, everyday for a week. See this link for some tips.

- Write a weather poem.
- Compose a piece of music comparing two different types of weather eg sun and storm or rain and snow.

Design a game to help someone learn about fractions. This could be about halves and quarters of number or shapes. Some children might spot the link between halving and dividing by 2.

Perhaps they could make flash cards, a board game, card game or an active game to be played in a bigger space.
