



Children have a choice and are asked to complete at least ONE task. They will have until the week beginning **Monday 26th March 2018**

Year Two Homework Choices - The Great Fire of London (Spring B 2018)



As Spring and Summer approach, we are going to be learning about seasonal changes and trees in our environment.

We are going to be using different art materials to explore signs of new life.

We are also going to consider the structure of trees and look carefully at the trunk and branches.

Can you create your own artwork based on trees? Can you use what you have learnt in our Art lessons and have a go with your family?




As part of our Geography week, we are going to be learning about Fairtrade and the life-changing impact this has on some people in our world. We are going to learn about Fairtrade bananas and we are going to make banana milkshake for the key stage one fairtrade café.

Can you present what you have learnt about Fairtrade to our class? You could make a factfile, newspaper report, video clip or even a piece of artwork to show you understand the importance of fairtrading in our world.

We are going to learn about fractions.

We are going to be finding fractions of shapes and numbers.



Can you write instructions to help someone in Year One who has not starting learning about fractions yet? What are the important things you need to remember? Can you include drawings or pictures to help them understand?

We are going to be learning about a story called 'Lila and the secret of rain' by David Conway. This is a beautiful story about a little girl who lives in a Kenyan village.

Can you explore other stories based in different countries? Do you know any other stories that take place in Africa? Can you have a go at writing your own story which is based in a different country?



We have now spent lots of time learning about the Great Fire of London. We have learnt about the causes of the fire, what happened during the fire, how it was stopped and what changed after the fire.

Can you demonstrate what you have learnt in a creative way? Can you create a piece of work which can teach people about the fire? You could make a quiz for your friends and family to complete or could make a board game or wordsearch of key words.
