Homework Choices Year 3 Autumn 2018

- Can you write a story with a seaside setting?

Imagine you live beside the sea. Write an story using this setting. You may want to use St Ives in Cornwall to give you ideas. Remember to use conjunctions and a range of punctuation.

- Can you write a report telling me all about St Ives in Cornwall?

What can you find out about St Ives in Cornwall? Show what you have discovered by writing a report. You will need to organise your writing into sub-headings. Why not include "Did you know?" boxes?

- Can you write a letter?

Imagine you are on holiday at the seaside. Write a letter explaining what you have seen and what you have done.

- Can you create a piece of music inspired by the sea?

You can use an instrument or your voice to create a piece of music. You could find a short video clip of the sea to fit the music with.

- Can you create a lighthouse?

You are responsible for designing and making a lighthouse. You can either draw a floor plan or, if you are feeling brave, make a model.

- Can you create a treasure map?

St Ives Cornwall has lots of coastline. Draw a treasure map to help smugglers know where everything is. There may be caves, beaches, paths to towns or even hidden tunnels.
