



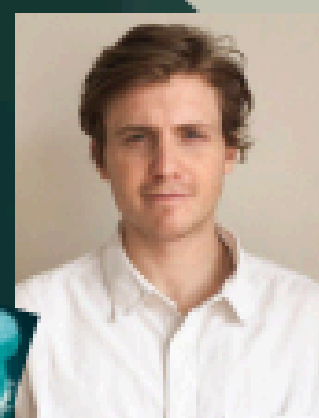
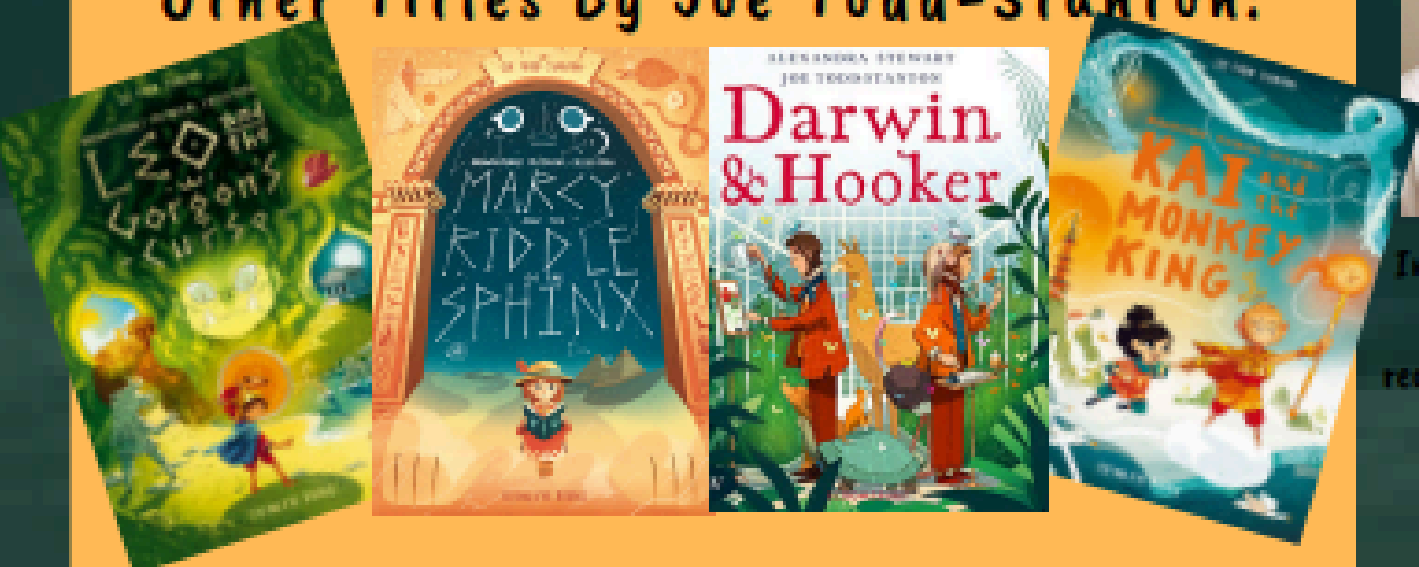
ARTHUR AND THE GOLDEN ROPE
