## Homework Choices Year 4 Spring 2 2019

Children have a choice and are asked to complete TWO tasks this half term, one from each column. In class we will be having a 'show and tell' session to celebrate the children's homework efforts. Please encourage your child to include some written work. If you have any questions, please speak to your class teacher.

Last term we learnt about how sounds are made and how pitch and volume affect how we hear things. We will also be having a music festival at the end of term. In order to support with this, we would like the children to design and make their own musical instruments. They could write about their instrument, how it works and how they made it.

Next term we will be learning about North American cultures (Native Americans) so you could research their food, transport systems, religious beliefs or something else, and present your work.

Last term we practised, rehearsed and performed our play; A Midsummer Night's Dream. As part of our DT and Art, we would like your child to create their own stage set for 'A Midsummer Night's Dream'. This could be designed on paper and/or made into their own model which they could share with us.

Next term we will be learning about rivers, the water cycle and flood defences, so you could research some of these things and present your work.
