



# KS1 SATs 2022

Information for parents and carers

## What are the KS1 SATS?

The KS1 SATs tests will be taken during May 2022.

The tests are not strictly timed and will take place in a familiar setting with a familiar adult.

Teachers will use these tests alongside their in depth knowledge of the children from throughout the year to make their own judgement of your child's attainment at the end of the academic year and this will be shared with you as part of their school report, as it is each year.

# Reading

There are two reading papers which will allow the children to demonstrate their ERIC reading skills. The style of questions that the children will be expected to answer are very similar to the questions we look at in whole class reading on a daily basis.

The first paper consists of short sections of text to read followed by questions which require the children to use what they have read to answer them.

In the second paper the children are given a longer reading booklet which they will read before answering a series of questions about the whole text.

# Maths

There are also two Maths papers that form part of the KS1 SATs.

The first paper focuses on arithmetic, this means that the children will be required to demonstrate their understanding of number, place value and calculation. This paper mainly consists of short answer questions but there will be times that they may wish to use space provided to show their working.

The second paper is a reasoning paper and looks at all areas of the maths curriculum. The questions in this paper are worded questions which require the children to either listen to the question read by an adult or read the question carefully themselves. The questions may include more than one step and it is often sensible for children to show their working.
