Year 1 kick started their term with an absolutely fantastic trip to the Cambridge Botanical Gardens!

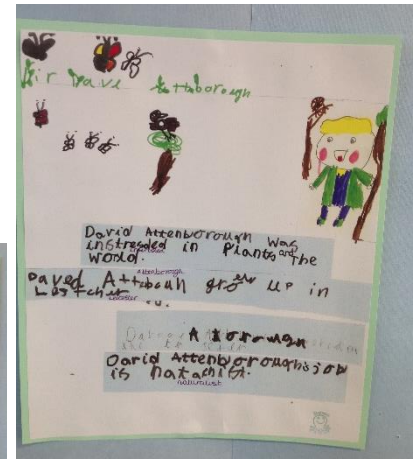
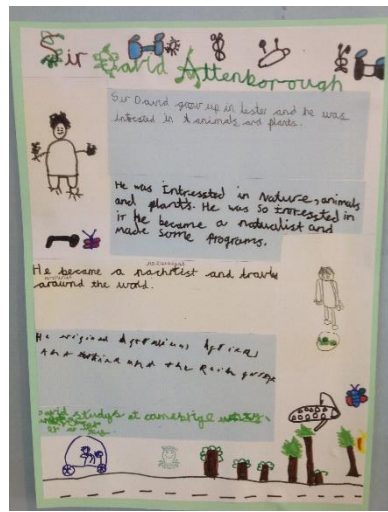
The children had the opportunity to explore the tropical houses; they planted their own seeds and even got a glimpse of the biggest seed in the world: the coco-de-mer!
