Pupil Premium Funding

This refers to money provided by the Government in order to support children who:

1. are in receipt of Free School Meals currently
2. have previously been eligible for Free School Meals in the last 6 years
3. are looked after or in the process of being adopted

A school is provided with funding of £1320 for each eligible child meeting criteria 1 and 2 and a higher rate of around £1500 for children meeting criterion 3. Each year the school receives different amounts of extra funding depending on the amount of pupils eligible.
