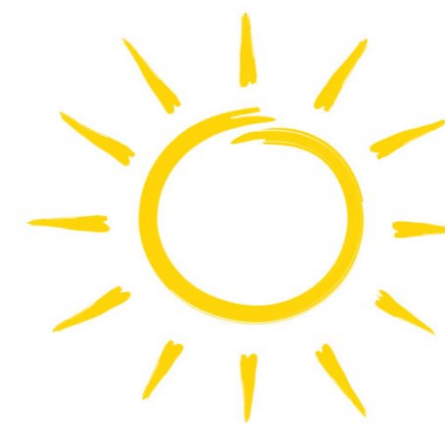




## Welcome back to the Summer Term!

**DT**  
In DT, we will be using our knowledge of electricity we learnt in science to make a shaky hands testers.

**PE**  
Children will be taking part in a variety of sporting activities including:

- Athletics
- Kwik Cricket
- Dance
- Learning to be Sports Leaders in preparation for Sports Day

**PSHE**  
In PSHE, the children will complete a unit about 'Body Image' and the different things that can affect this.

They will also learn about Financial Education, and how money choices affect wellbeing, how to make the most of money and how to stay safe with digital money.

**Maths**  
As mathematicians, the children will be looking at the following areas:

- Angles and Geometry
- Algebra
- Problem solving
- Revision for SATs

**English - Reading & Writing**  
As readers and writers, we will be delving into a range of texts to develop our skills. We will link these to our learning in other curriculum areas (such as The Windrush Generation and World Wars).

**Music**  
As musicians, we will be listening to and appraising African rhythm and melody (drumming), working on the Year 6 production and working on our Leavers' song unit.

**Art**  
In Art we will be creating digital art, responding to the Artwork of the Bauhaus movement, and thinking about geometry and perspective to create digital art.

**Computing**  
In computing, we will be identifying, collecting and analysing different types of data and then manipulating and representing them for a variety of audiences and purposes. We will also be creating programme systems and digital content whilst also considering aesthetics, functionality and the impact on the user.

**History**  
In History, we will be learning about Britain During the Wars. We will:

- Explore technologies used in warfare before 1900
- Learn about WWI
- Explore the life of a frontline soldier in WWI
- Use historical sources of evidence to discover what life was like for women in WWI
- Learn about weaponry in WWI

**Science**  
As scientists, we will be exploring light. We will be learning about light sources, how light travels, how we see and what light is made up of.

**Religion and Worldviews**  
In Religion and Worldviews, we will be looking at the religion of Buddhism and learning about the Prince who became Buddha.

**Geography**  
As geographers, we will be learning:

- How to read and use the 8 points of a compass
- How to read and use four and six figure grid references.
- How to read and use map symbols and keys
