Key facts:

Continents: There are seven continents. Europe, Asia, South America, North America, Antarctica, Africa and Oceania.

Oceans: There are 5 oceans. These are Pacific Ocean, Atlantic Ocean, Indian Ocean, Southern Ocean and Arctic Ocean.

St Ives is in **Cambridgeshire** which is in **England**. England is in **Europe**.

North Pole: The North Pole is located in the Arctic Ocean, which is covered by a large sheet of floating ice. There is no land at the North Pole.

South Pole: The most southern part of the world.

There was a huge fire in St Ives in 1689. During this fire, 122 houses were burnt down! St Ives is named after St Ivo who was a Cornish bishop.

Key vocabulary:

Continent: This is a large land mass on the Earth's surface. Continents are made up of different countries.

Oceans: A vast body of water that covers the majority of the globe.

Human features: Features that are created by people.

Physical features: Features that occur through nature.

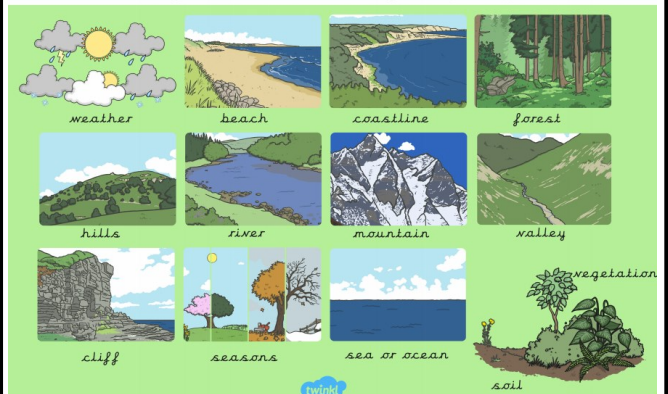
Weather: Weather is sunshine, rain, snow, wind, and storms. It's what is going on outside right now. The weather is different at different places around the planet.

Equator: The equator is an imaginary circle around the middle of the Earth. It divides Earth into two equal parts: the Northern Hemisphere and the Southern Hemisphere.

City: A place in which people live and work that is larger than a town. A city must have a cathedral.

Town: A thickly settled area that is usually larger than a village but smaller than a city.
