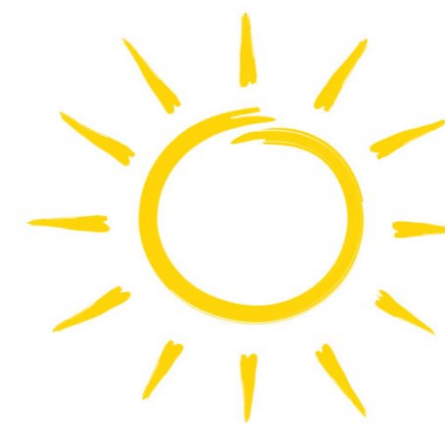




Welcome back to Summer A!

PE
In Indoor PE, we are going to be furthering our dance knowledge with a 'Cold Places' dance.
In Outdoor PE, we are going to be learning cricket.

PSHE
We will be exploring personal safety. We will be thinking about adults that we feel safe around, things that might give us funny feeling that we need to say 'no' to and touches that make us uncomfortable.

Maths
As mathematicians we will be looking at the following areas:

- Column subtraction
- Fractions (unit and non-unit)
- Multiplication (2, 4 and 8 times tables)

English-Reading & Writing
As readers and writers, we will be using a range of stimuli to develop our fluency, comprehension and writing skills:

- Ulf the Finger Eater by Dick King-Smith
- Learning our script for our Dragon Days performance

Music
As musicians, we will be developing our notation skills and will think about how we can improvise our own song.

Science
As scientists we will be experimenting with different things that plants need to grow properly.

Art
As artists we will be using a watercolour painting techniques to create artwork which is inspired by Georgia O'Keefe. This is linked to our Science learning.

Religion and World Views
In Religion and Worldviews we will be exploring what it means to live as a Jew.
We will also be learning about Joseph, Moses and the Exodus.

Artsmark
We will be making links and connections between our Art and our Science learning. Our Programming work in Computing will link to our Music learning.

History
As historians we will be learning more about Ancient Greece. We will be looking at:

- Democracy
- Peloponnesian War
- Greek Literature
- Odyssey
- Philosophy

Geography
As geographers we will be learning about how volcanoes form and what happens when they erupt. We will focus on the differences between lava and magma and the impact that this has on people who live near volcanoes.

Computing
In Computing we will be further developing our programming skills. We will look at how we can follow instructions and use these to programme BeeBots and sprites on Scratch Jr.
