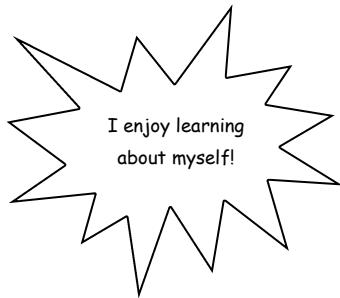

Can you make a guide from your house to school? Can you explain the ways that others can keep safe?



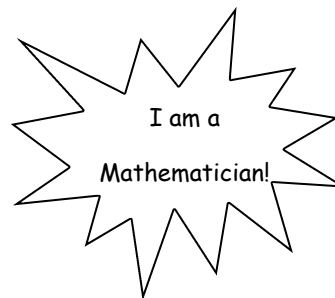
When we find an author that we love, it's really tempting to read lots of their books!

What can you do in a minute? How long does it take you to walk to school? How many minutes does it take you to lay the table at dinner time? Can you record the information you collect in a table?

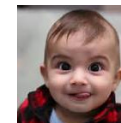


In RE we are learning about celebrating new life.
