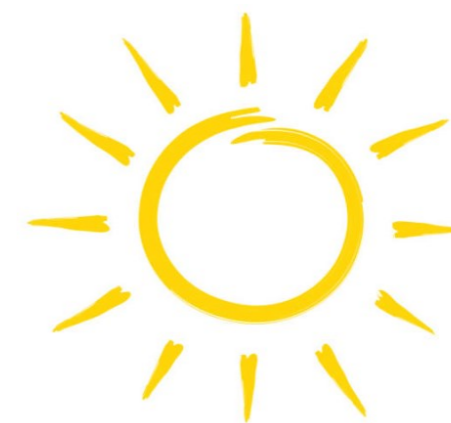




Welcome back to the Summer Term!

Food for Life

We will be exploring a range of preparation skills and consider healthy eating choices.

DT

Music

Art

As artists we will be developing our painting skills linked to our work on the Amazon.

Artsmark

Computing

In Computing we will be continuing our Programming Unit and then learning about creating videos and editing our work. We will also be developing our programming skills and having discussions about e-safety.

PSHE

Maths

As mathematicians we will be looking at the following areas:

English-Reading

In Reading we will be immersing ourselves in texts to develop our comprehension skills in answering ERIC questions. Macbeth and The Explorer will be our key texts this term to allow us to apply our reading skills.

Science

As scientists we will be beginning the term by exploring life cycles. We will be learning about the reproductive cycle of plants and different classifications of animals.

Religion and World Views
