Can you research, design and create a shield?

At the end of our Topic, Medieval Britain, we will be having a big banquet to celebrate the learning over the term.

We would like you to research using books, the internet, or other resources how to create your own shield to bring to the end of term banquet.

You will need to research the colours, typical symbols and battle designs they used to have. You might want to include elements that we have learnt over the past few weeks such as; castles, myths and legends and key medieval vocabulary.

Use your imagination to ensure your shield tells a story about what you have learnt!

Imagine we have a group of new Year 6 children.

We would like you to create a poster or leaflet for them to explain everything we have learnt in Maths so far.

This includes:

- Ordering numbers up to 10 million
- Writing numbers in words
- Rounding numbers up to 10 million
- Calculating negative numbers

Be creative! What helped you in lessons?

Have you got any tips, rhymes or games that can help them with their Maths? Remember to add common misconceptions.
